What are VLE classes?

These courses allow pupils from any Falkirk school to access a subject virtually that either isn't already offered in their school, or isn't offered at a time that they can attend.

These courses can help pupils develop skills that will be useful beyond school such as independent learning and time management skills.

As part of the VLE pupils have:

- Access to the course via Teams or Google Classroom
- Between 4 and 5 periods per week of 'live learning' online
- All other periods are self-directed study/ learning set out by their teacher
- Termly in-person meet-ups with their class
